**NEW LECTIONARY:** The lectionary is changing as part of the continuing process of revising liturgical translations. The new lectionary will come into force on the first Sunday of Advent 2024. Parishes will not be able to keep using the old lectionary and will need to change over to the new one by 1 December. As I'm sure you will appreciate, this will be quite expensive for our five Churches costing approximately £4000. If anyone would like

to donate towards the cost, please contact the office. Donations in excess of £100 please and we will add a name card into the lectionary. Each new set contains four lectionaries.

**4<sup>th</sup> WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY:** Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2024. We will celebrate this day in honour of all grandparents and elderly members of our parishes next week. This is the closest Sunday to the feast of St Anne and St Joachim, which we celebrate the Friday before on the 26<sup>th</sup> of July 2024. Pope Francis has written a message especially for this occasion and the Diocese has created a booklet that includes his message and the prayer prepared for the day.
